

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

### **SULLIVAN SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 AND VILLAGE OF SULLIVAN REGARDING FACILITY PLANNING FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES AND POTENTIAL USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT/LOAN ASSISTANCE**

Public hearings will be held at the following locations:

Village of Sullivan - 6:00 PM on Tuesday, the 23rd day of April, 2019 at Sullivan Veterans Park, 408 Grove Avenue, Sullivan, Wisconsin

Sullivan Sanitary District No. 1 –6:00 PM on Wednesday, the 24th day of April, 2019 at the Town of Sullivan Hall, N3866 West Street (Rome, behind St. Luke's Church), Sullivan, Wisconsin

The purpose of each hearing is to discuss and review the Facilities Planning Document for the Village and District wastewater treatment facilities. Upgrades to these facilities are needed to comply with current and future Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources permit requirements, repair or replace equipment that is nearing the end of its useful life, and upgrade the facilities to meet each community's current and future needs. A joint treatment facility is proposed that would include pumping wastewater from the Village of Sullivan to an upgraded treatment plant at the Sullivan Sanitary District.

- Current and Future Permit Requirements
- Alternatives Evaluated
- Review of Alternatives Selected
- Implementation Schedule
- Environmental Effects
- User Charge Impacts

The Village of Sullivan and Sullivan Sanitary District No. 1 intend to file an application for federal financial assistance with the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Rural Utilities Service. The specific objective of this application is to receive low interest loans and grant assistance for the proposed joint treatment facility, including the wastewater treatment plant upgrade, lift station and force main. Any comments regarding this application should be submitted to the Village or the District.

A copy of the Facilities Planning Document will be available for review at the Sullivan Village Hall, and the Town of Sullivan Hall. All interested parties are encouraged to attend or send their comments, in writing, to the Village of Sullivan or Sullivan Sanitary District No. 1 at the addresses below.
